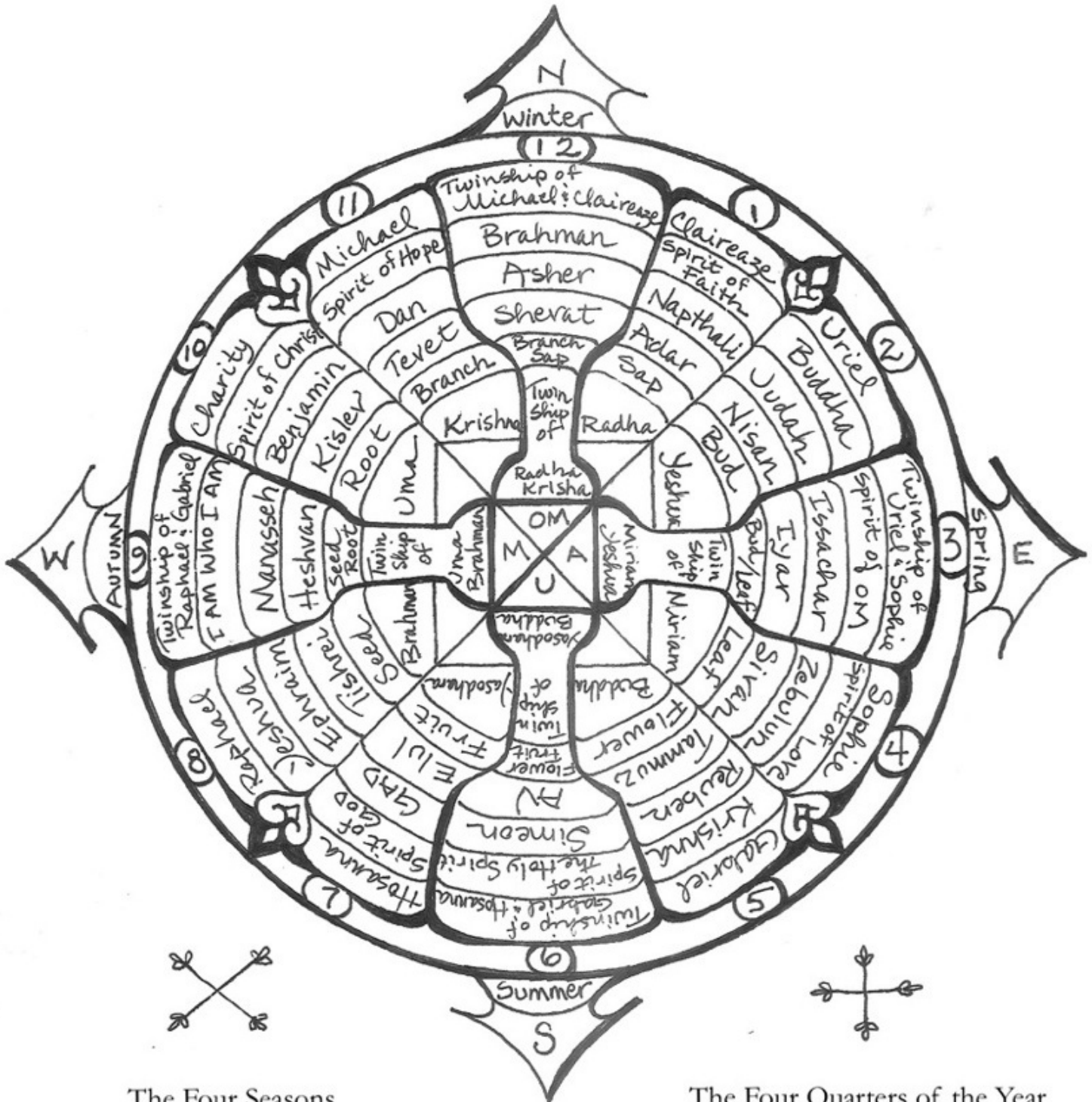


The Calendar Wheel



The Four Seasons start at the New Moons of

- West - Tishrei - Brahman
- North - Tevet - Krishna
- East - Nisan - Yeshua
- South - Tammuz - Buddha

The Four Quarters of the Year begin and end with the minor holidays of Rachel's Yahrzeit (death)

- 15 mid Heshvan
- 15 Tu b' Shevat
- 15 Iyar
- 15 Tu b' Av

The Key to the Calendar Wheel

Outside of Circle		Direction and Season
Inner Rim		Time - as the Hours of a Day
1st Ring		Archangels and placement of Their Twinship
2nd Ring		Ascended Master or one of the Seven Spirits of Time associated with each Tribe and Space of Time
3rd Ring		Name of the Twelve Tribes of Israel
4th Ring		Name of the Hebrew Calendar Month
5th Ring		The Tree-stages of the Year
6th Ring		The Twinship of the Four Ascended Masters who govern each Season of the Year (The Four make up the Fifth Ascended Master as The I Am Presence)
7th Ring		The Beginnings of Time as A - U - M - OM
