With the donations made in the month of July, 2019, Aremu was able to purchase cement for 350,000.00 and reserve 200,000.00 for the cement blocks to be made. He could have gone to the local distributor and bought cement blocks already made, but that would have cost millions of Naira (Nigerian money) so instead Aremu had the cement brought to his land. The block makers are still in the process of making 7,000 bricks.













Payment for the architect was also a huge expense for the month of July. It is a law within the country of Nigeria that The House of Amen has to be registered. The set fee

is prescribed as to the amount of land surrounding The House. Another 8,000.00 US or 3,000,000 in Nigeria money was charged to this cause. Aremu informed me that the nice women in the office building agreed to let him pay in installments. Thanks be to God.







At this point, Aremu has the supplies he needs for installing the electricity which will be taken care of soon. More pressing matters in the month of July included payment to the architect, the government, the cement and block makers all had to be addressed first.
