In 2017, Aremu realized the community had outgrown the small house and that he needed to begin building the church of his dreams.






He and his people dug the foundation and then poured the concrete, not by any heavy machinery that we are accustomed to, all mixed and poured by hand.





This is where the church stands in its progress today. Sadly, Aremu ran out of funding from his own pocket and had to call a halt to the construction of his church.





In May of 2019, Jayson and I embraced the challenge to invest in Aremu's dream. With our first donation, he invested in 10 temporary poles for electricity. He is currently making progress on installing them. These 10 poles will also bring electricity to the surrounding homes in the area. This act of sharing will go far in keeping the peace.





Mrs Aremu Funmilayo is now using the first building used for the House of Amen as a nursery and primary school for the community. The school is their only means of an income at this time.



We consider Aremu to be our brother and our friend, and we would like to help him complete his church.

Aremu informed us that it will take 10,000 US dollars to complete his church. Jayson and I are going to send all donations made to Ascension Reiki to the cause of meeting this goal for Aremu and building the House of Amen.
