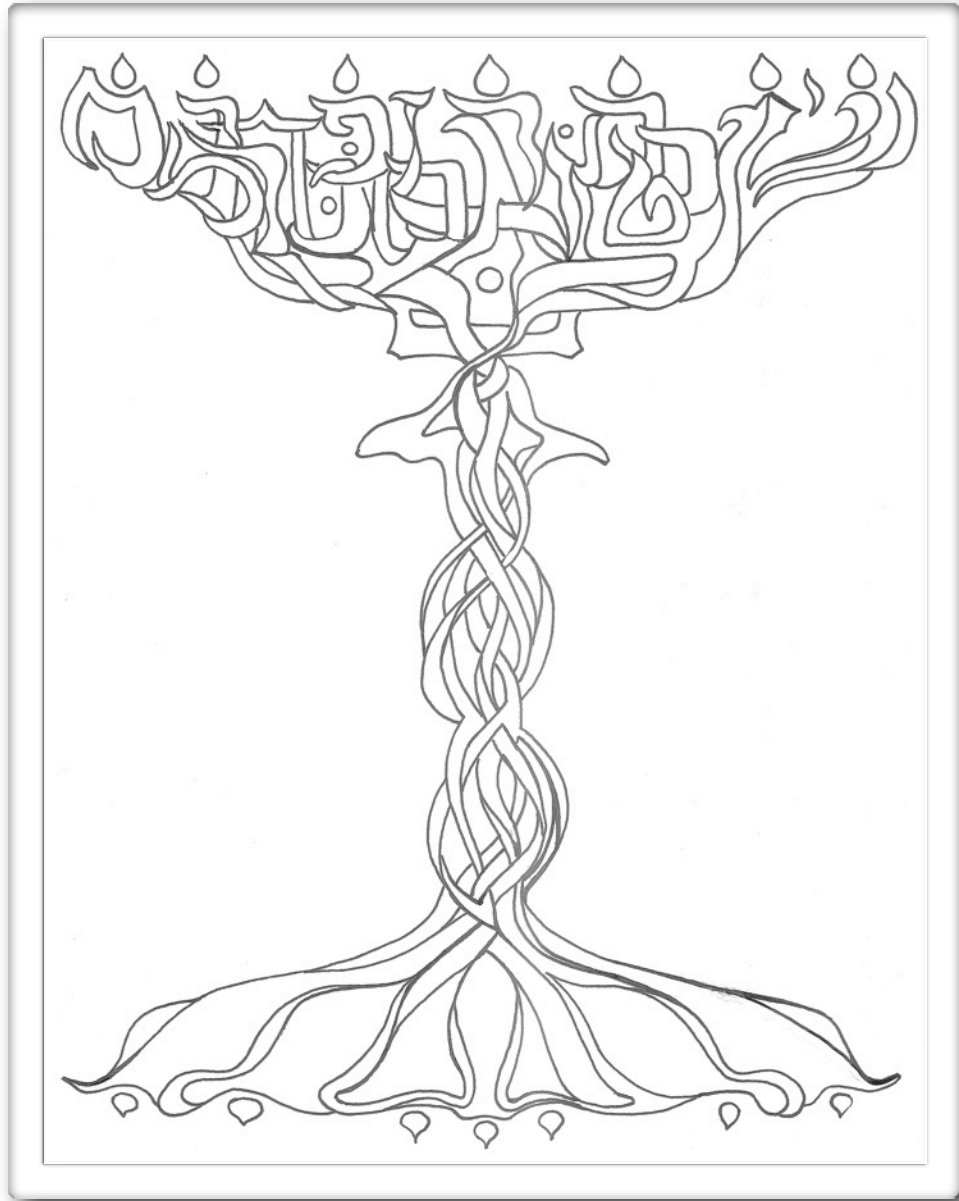


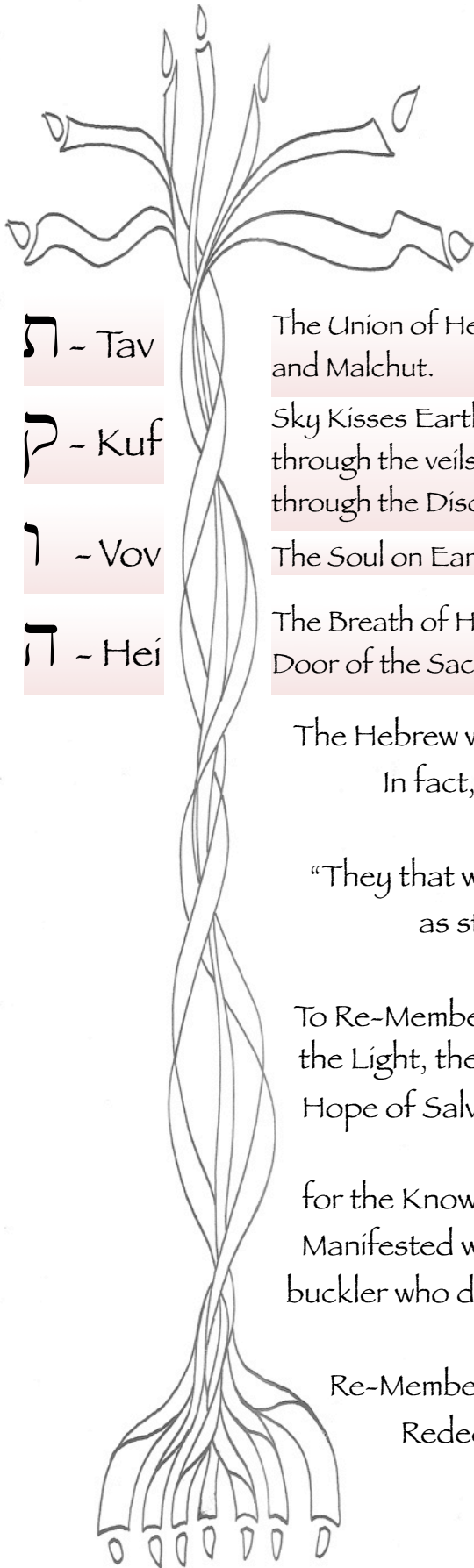
The Cup of Salvation

The Hebrew words, Tikvah and Kavah come from the same root.

In fact, you can see the word, Kavah, within Tikvah.

Kavah means to trust or to hope.

“They that wait.” Originally, Kavah meant to “twist” or “weave” as strands of a rope, making a tool capable of holding a heavy load securely.

To Re-Member the Golden Cord, as the Thread that Binds us to the Light, the LifeLine of Our Heavenly Home, is to receive The Hope of Salvation through the Torah of the Unmanifested from the Knowledge of Kabbalah,
